

# Instructions for BarryUWireless (Apple Macbook)

Barry wireless uses 802.1x type secure authentication, authorization and accounting. The 802.1x client, if configured properly for Barry, will prompt you for your BarryNet username and password, the same credentials that you use to log in to your e-mail or office and lab computers.

The configuration settings below will affect the laptop only when it's on the Barry wireless network. It will not affect how you connect to other wireless networks, such as in your home.

## Manual Configuration for Macbook

1. Click on the **Airport** (top right-hand corner) icon and select **Join Other Network**.



2. For the **Network Name**, type **BarryUWireless** (the name is case-sensitive) and select **WPA2 Enterprise** from the **Security** drop-down menu.



- For the username:
  - Students:** type your Barry Email address (example: [jane.doe@mymail.barry.edu](mailto:jane.doe@mymail.barry.edu))
  - Faculty/Staff:** type your username only (example: [jdoe](#))
- Once you're done typing your username, type your password, and click **Join**.



- The **BarryUWireless** network is now configured.
